ICMS Professional Scholarship

Open to: Australian high school students who are completing their final school year (year 12).

Value: Up to \$29,000.

These scholarships are offered for study commencing at ICMS in February. In addition to financial support, community-minded students have the opportunity to demonstrate their leadership skills to future employers. As a scholarship holder, you will be encouraged to participate in the ICMS community through a professional student ambassador role or through extensive access to the executive management of ICMS.

Selection Criteria: Evidence of all-round achievement in your school and the broader community. This includes academic performance, extra-curricular activities and work experience.



Aspiring Education Foundation Equity Scholarship

Open to: Australian high school students who are completing their final school year (year 12).

Value: The AEF Committee determines the level and value of each scholarship awarded.

At ICMS we want you to reach your potential. Through the Aspiring Education Foundation (AEF), ICMS awards equity scholarships to help secondary school students in Australia experiencing financial hardship to achieve their tertiary goals. The scholarships are available for tuition fees and/or accommodation expenses.

Selection Criteria: Evidence of financial hardship is required. Academic results and community engagement will also be considered.



ANZ Scholarship

Open to: Australian students entering the Bachelor of Business Management. Other degrees will be considered.

Value: Over \$17,000. Includes 12-14 weeks full-time paid work placement at ANZ.

We have partnered with ANZ to present this unique scholarship for new students commencing the Bachelor of Business Management and will also consider students enrolling in other courses who show potential to be business leaders. This scholarship prepares students for a career in business management with a 12-14 week full-time paid work placement within the ANZ organisation. This experience and exposure to the world of corporate banking will be of enormous value on the resume of a young professional leader.

Selection Criteria: You must display enthusiasm and motivation for your studies and a career in corporate business. Academic results, leadership roles – past and present, business interests and work experience will also be considered.

Open to: Australian students entering the ICMS Bachelor of Hospitality Management.

Value: Over \$17,000 tuition scholarship.

Value: Up to \$40,000 in tuition fees and/or accommodation credit.

CONTINUING STUDENTS SCHOLARSHIPS



ACCOR Scholarship

Open to: ICMS students enrolled in a Bachelor of Hospitality, Event or Business Management degree.*

Value: \$10,000 of tuition fees and potential graduate employment.

ICMS has partnered with ACCOR Hotels to present this unique scholarship for ICMS students entering their final year of their hospitality degree. The experience and exposure to the hospitality industry with this leading international hotel company will be of enormous value on the C.V. of a passionate hospitality student looking for a career in hospitality management.

Selection Criteria: You must display enthusiasm and motivation for your studies and a career in the hospitality industry. Leadership roles – past and present, business interests and community contributions will all be taken into consideration.

*Bachelor of Event & Business Management applicants must have adequate previous work experience in the Hospitality Industry to be eligible to apply.



Northern Beaches Council Scholarship

Open to: ICMS students enrolled in an Event Management degree.

Value: Includes a 4-subject fee-waiver and an amount of \$300 paid weekly during a 14-week full-time internship.

This is an exciting opportunity to gain invaluable experience working on key international events such as the Manly Food and Wine Festival, Manly Jazz Festival, Australian citizenship ceremonies and other major events. Completing a 14-week full-time internship working as part of a dedicated events team, you will develop, plan and deliver events to assist Northern Beaches Council to meet its strategic business goals.

Selection Criteria: You must be enrolled in the Bachelor of Event Management or Bachelor of Business Management with a specialisation in Event Management. You will be entering trimester three of your studies or beyond. You must demonstrate consistency in academic and professional performance and overall contribution to ICMS.



Black & White Waiters Scholarship

Open to: ICMS Students enrolled in a Hospitality or Events Management degree.

Value: Up to \$7,500 of tuition fees, and potential work placement.

ICMS has partnered with Black & White Waiters to present this unique scholarship opportunity for students currently in term 1 or 2 of their Bachelor degree. The successful recipient will receive a tuition waiver to the value of up to \$7,500 and potential work placement. The experience and exposure to the world of Events Management will make the recipients C.V. stand out, while also creating many potential networking moments.



Courtney-O'Connor Scholarship

Open to: Current students entering the third (final) year of study at ICMS.

Value: Up to \$29,400. Includes tuition fee waiver of up to 12 subjects and a work placement (8 hours per week during one trimester) within the ICMS.

Each trimester, the Courtney-O'Connor Scholarship recognises a second year student who exhibits leadership, community service and academic excellence. This combination of skills and talent is not rare at ICMS and the application process is competitive. Scholarship recipients with exceptional business acumen and presentation skills may experience the opportunity of executing their own business idea during the work placement hours.

Selection Criteria: You must be a current ICMS student completing trimester six of your degree (entering your final year of study). You must demonstrate consistency in academia, professional performance, overall leadership and contribution to ICMS.



Academic Excellence Scholarship

Open to: ICMS students who have completed at least 16 subjects.

Value: Up to \$20,000.

These scholarships are highly competitive and highly regarded as they reflect the academic best at ICMS and scholarship recipients will have the opportunity to represent ICMS at academic, community and promotional events. There are two scholarships available each trimester, two for the students with the highest cumulative GPA.

Selection Criteria: You must have a cumulative GPA of 4.50 or higher.



Postgraduate Innovation Scholarship

Open to: Current postgraduate student who has completed 1st two trimesters.

Value: up to 4 subject tuition waiver

Applications for this scholarship are invited from students in the second semester of their Master degree at ICMS.

Selection Criteria: You must be a current ICMS Master student completing semester two of your program (entering your final year of study). You must have completed four subjects in your first semester of the Masters with a minimum GPA of 3.5. You must have demonstrated consistency in academia, and excellence in innovation, professional performance, and overall contribution to ICMS.

Selection Criteria:

- Academic record
- Essay submission (minimum 1000 words)
- Community, leadership and student body contributions

NEW INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS SCHOLARSHIPS



Postgraduate Innovation Scholarship

Open to: New Master's Students

Value: up to 6 subject tuition waiver.

Partial Scholarships may be awarded. Subject to approval by ICMS Management. Applications for this scholarship are invited from students in the second semester of their Master degree at ICMS.

ICMS is offering a scholarship to a Postgraduate student who will be commencing their studies at ICMS in a 2-year Master program. The scholarship is awarded based on a three-component application process, which will result in the successful applicant being awarded a scholarship of up to AU\$17,700*.

Eligibility Criteria: Applicants need to meet the ICMS entry requirements in English language proficiency for Master Degree level study.

Applicants must have a GPA of 3.5 from their previous undergraduate degree. This scholarship is available for both domestic and international students.

Selection Criteria:

- Academic and English requirements
- Essay submission (minimum 1000 words)



ICMS International Scholarships

Open to: International students entering an ICMS Bachelor degree.

Value: Up to \$25,000.

ICMS is part of a global community, attracting high achieving students from around the world. If you are a current ICMS student and applying for the Academic Excellence Scholarship, you must complete an application form to be considered. Submit your application in the trimester that you will be completing the minimum number of subjects required (16 subjects for Business Management students or 20 for Specialist Bachelor students).
